He got the support he needed from Aspen Dental in Trussville, AL.

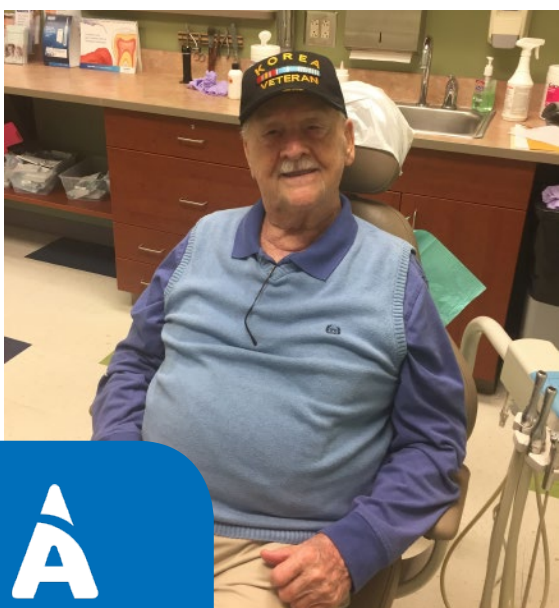
Kenneth worked with Trussville OM Latoya Clayton and was able to secure third-party financing and a small amount of coverage. He was on his way to affording the smile he deserved.
